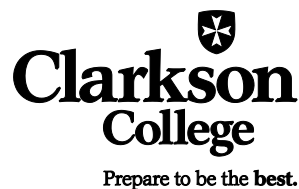

Clarkson College accepts transfer credit from Chadron State College. The transfer guide shows how courses completed at Chadron State College will be transferred to Clarkson College. It is important for students transferring credit to Clarkson College to submit a final official transcript after completing all course work from other institutions. Students must receive a grade of “C-” or higher to be considered for transfer credit. Clarkson College does not accept transfer credit for courses taken after enrollment at Clarkson College.

The following Community Health certificates are available at Clarkson College:

- Gerontology
- Human Services
- Public Health
- Women’s Health

General Education Courses

These courses serve as a foundation for Certificate programs. All courses are offered at Clarkson College and are not necessary for admission. General education courses may be taken concurrently with major/certificate courses.

Students with an associate degree or higher in a healthcare field may have the prerequisites waived after review by the admitting Program Director.
